






4th Street Revitalization Goals

- Create a Safer Environment for All: Cars, Pedestrians, Bicyclists
- Develop a unique Identity for 4th Street
- Keep & Attract Business in the Village
- Attract Private Investment






Contrast of Phase 1 and Phase 2

Phase 1- Intentional Intensity of Design- .5 miles

- Concentration of businesses
- Potential for turnover of inappropriate uses in a business district
- Significant opportunity for residential infill
- VLR reduced budgetary spending for more than a decade to fund 90% of the project


Phase 2-Level of Design- 1.5 miles

- Significant gaps in business density
- Significant opportunity for commercial and residential development
- Continuing agricultural uses
- Significant opportunity for open space uses
- Significant gaps in funding
- El Pueblo intersection-Gateway District



Phases

- 1.5 Mile Stretch:
- Phase 2a: Pueblo Solano to Ranchitos
- Phase 2b: Ranchitos to El Pueblo
- Phase 2c: El Pueblo to Village Limit



4th Street Phase 2: Where we are

- Engineering : \$1,258,091 fully funded (State Road Fund/TPF/VLR)
 - Currently in 100% Design to be complete by October 2024
- Construction cost estimates: Pueblo Solano to Village Limits \$27,700,495
- Identified as the #1 priority on the ICIP and for capital outlay.

Project Components:

- Reduce four-lane road to two lanes and add a center two-way left turn lane
- Construct ADA sidewalk and trails
- Stormwater drainage system
- Add landscaping, lighting and bus stops
- El Pueblo Roundabout and intersection improvement throughout



Phase 2a: Construction Pueblo Solano to Ranchitos Road \$8,969,410

- 2a Funding Secured: \$2,650,000
 - 2021 Appropriation CN C3212988 \$250,000 Reverts 6/30/2025
 - 2022 Appropriation \$400,000 Reverts 6/30/2026
 - 2023 TPF funds/VLR match \$1,500,000 Reverts June 30, 2025 and cannot be mingled with Federal Funds
 - 2023 Legislative Appropriation \$500,000 (Thank you!)
- 2a Funding Gap: \$6,319,410—must be State/Local funds

Phase 2b-2c: Ranchitos to Village Limits

- Funding Secured: \$1,000,000
 - FY24 COVID Relief Funds \$1,000,000 must be obligated by September 2024
 - Federal TIP: \$5M
 - Local Match \$800,000 (FY 26)
- Note:
 - Phase 2b includes a Roundabout at El Pueblo
 - Phases 2b, 2c will include a hybrid trail/bike lane in coordination with the Bernalillo County Road Diet from Alameda Blvd.
 - All phases will be context sensitive design based on existing conditions
